NM uses a 3 tiered system which allows teachers to advance through a salary schedule based on years of experience and education. There is a great expectation that the NM Legislature and Governor's Office are taking steps to increase the levels of licensure, with Level 1 starting at a minimum of \$40,000 for the 2019-2020 school year.

Hobbs is located just a few miles west of the Texas border on the eastern edge of the state. With a population of more than 44,000, the community enjoys mild winters and warm summers. The moderate climate allows for comfortable outdoor recreation year-round. While the rest of the nation has experienced an economic downturn, Hobbs industry remains stable with an unemployment rate of less than 5 percent. According to a recent Census Bureau study, Hobbs is the 8th fastest micropolitan area in the US.

Hobbs Municipal schools is devoted to providing a world class education to the children in our community. As a district who practices the tenets of professional learning communities, we believe Mentoring our new teachers is vital to developing and maintaining academic excellence in our district. Our district is lead by Superintendent TJ Parks, a believer in providing Inviting Schools to our community.



HMS currently has an enrollment of just over 10,000 students. (72 percent Hispanic, 23 percent Anglo and 4 percent Black). That figure is the highest in school history and reflects a booming local economy.

Students attend one of 13 elementary schools (one serves only kindergartners), three middle schools, one freshman school, one high school and one alternative learning school.

Sixty percent of HMS students qualify for free and reduced lunch and thus are deemed low income or Title 1 schools, allowing for Teacher Loan Forgiveness application programs.

Students at two Hobbs elementary schools benefit from a Dual Language program, a curriculum which offers the chance to become fluent in English and Spanish. An added benefit is the chance to learn an appreciation for different cultures. Students, who are an equal mix of Spanish and English speakers, receive half the day's instruction in Spanish and the other half in English.
